Pre-Camper Team

Pre-camper Lead Teacher

Pre-camper Lead teacher is responsible for the planning, preparing, leading and implementing the lessons following the current camp curriculum for the attending pre-campers ages 1-7 during all designated times. The lead teacher is responsible for creating activities or crafts to reinforce the daily camp theme and communicating with the camp Director to stay within the allotted budget for the given year. They are also responsible for managing and communicating the schedule of the Pre-camper team to ensure that the program is adequately staffed during all designated times. The Pre-Camper Lead Teacher is also responsible for the duties of the Pre-Camper Assistant Teacher.

Pre-camper Assistant Teacher

Pre-camper Assistant Teachers are responsible for assisting, teaching and the supervision of pre-campers during their scheduled designated times.

Essential Responsibilities

- Be prepared to teach the daily lessons during the designated class time.
- Create activities or crafts to reinforce the focus of each day's lesson
- Daily supervision and spiritual guidance of the pre-campers
- Help prepare them for challenges, conflicts and temptations they are likely to face, while also providing them with the basic Biblical knowledge they need.
- Follow camp objectives, rules, policies, and guidelines
- Set expectations for behavior, dress, language, as well as basic hygiene
- Be punctual and organized
- Problem solve through situations and seek assistance when necessary
- Work to ensure all pre-campers are comfortable, safe, and included
- Know where pre-campers are at during all program designated times
- Attend scheduled meetings and trainings
- Participate enthusiastically and Have fun!

Qualifications - Required

- Love Jesus, loves kids, have a healthy relationship with Jesus
- Demonstrated experience working with children
- Ability to teach and lead various biblical activities, skits, discussions.
- Excellent character, integrity and adaptability. Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control
- · Ability to communicate and work with a variety of age and skill levels
- The desire and ability to work in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere
- Pass background check.
- Need to be available for training, which will be announced.
- Ability to work as a member of a team and the ability to accomplish tasks with little direct supervision.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.

Physical Demands

• Must have the physical ability to lead and participate in camp activities which include, but are not limited to, hiking, canoeing, swimming, team building initiatives, physical games, and activities.
