

Camp Fire MC

This person will be responsible for the preparation, organization, and leading of the camps nightly campfire program of evening entertainment for all campers and staff.

Essential Responsibilities

- Prepare nightly Entertainment with skits, songs, and games -This needs to be 90% camper participation 10% staff.
- Work with the curriculum to pick skits and songs that work with and support the year's camp theme.
- Skits should be assigned the day before so all cabins have time to prepare. (keeping in mind that our age levels differ and include 9-18 years old)
- Stay within the given budget and come to camp with prepared props, costumes or any items needed for skits
- Know and understand ALL emergency procedures associated with the camp program.
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the camp areas. This includes but is not limited to being responsible for the campers' safety and their whereabouts at all times.

Requirements

Qualifications - *Required*

- A healthy relationship with Jesus
- Creativity, organization, public speaker; ability to command a large crowd.
- Experience in camp, youth programs, recreation, working with children, or in a related field.
- Ability to lead, plan, organize, and implement program activities.
- Ability to work as a member of a team and the ability to accomplish tasks with little direct supervision.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.

Physical Demands

- Must have the physical ability to lead and participate in camp activities which include, but are not limited to, team building initiatives, building campfires, physical games, and activities.
- You may be asked to participate and support other camp roles throughout the day.

Special Notes:

- References- (Pastor, Elder, Ministry leader, Mentor etc.) may be requested for consideration of this role
- Minimum 1 year of recent attendance as a staff member at Sierra Bible Camp, Stockton, Lodi and Galt experience is required before being considered for this role.
- This role is not available for those attending with Pre-Campers unless prior arrangements have been met and approved by Camp Committee and Director
- Final decision of staff personnel is at the discretion of the Camp Committee, Lead Boys and Girls Counselors and/or Camp Director.
